**Outreach Committee Meeting:** July 22, 6:30 PM

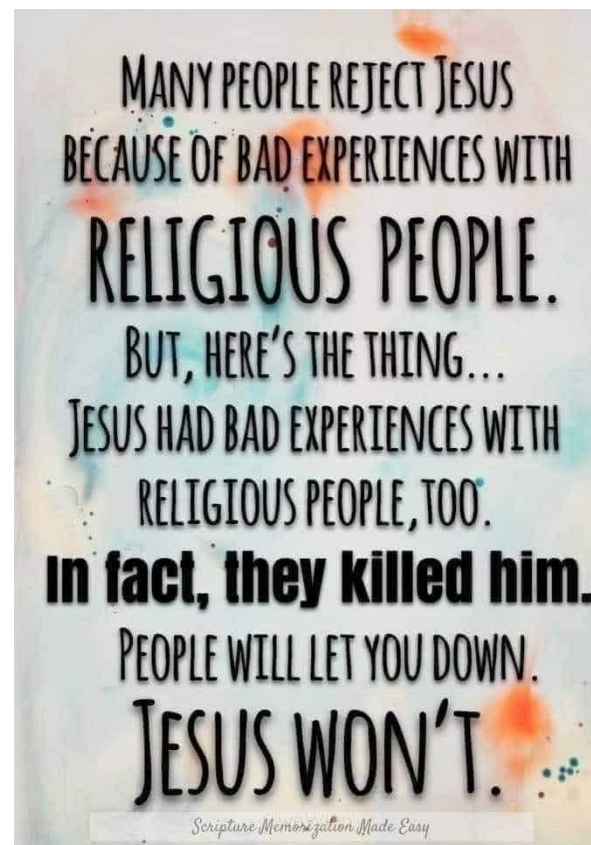

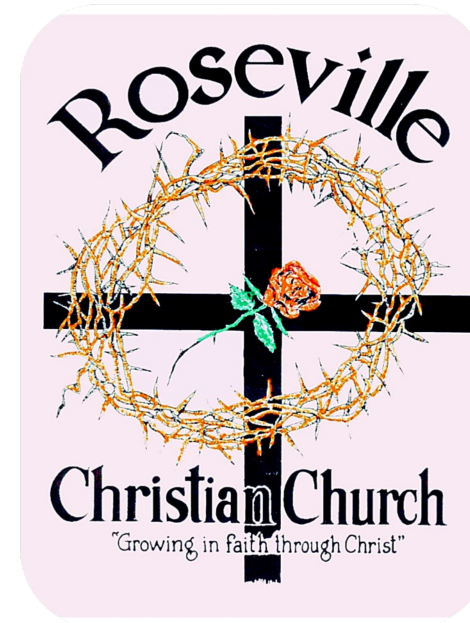
